

**NURSERY – MISS BRADY  
AUTUMN TERM 2017**

**ENGLISH**

- Traditional stories, rhymes and poems
- Phoneme of the week
- To recognise and write own name
- To form letters correctly
- Writing/mark making independently
- To ascribe meaning to marks
- To have emerging self-confidence to speak to others about wants and interests.

**MATHS**

- To say and use the number names to 5 in order, in familiar contexts such as number rhymes, songs, stories, counting games and activities.
- To recite the number names in order from 1- 5.
- To recite the number names in order from 1- 10.
- To count reliably up to 2 everyday objects, giving just one number name to each object.
- To use language such as circle and bigger to describe the shape and size of solids and flat shapes.
- To count reliably up to 5 everyday objects, giving just one number name to each object.
- To use language such as more or less, longer or shorter to compare two quantities by making direct comparisons of length.

**TOPIC**

**ALL ABOUT ME**

The children will learn a great deal during these first weeks about relationships and interacting with people who may be different from themselves. They will have opportunities to play alone, alongside and with other children and in doing this become aware of rules and acceptable behaviour. They will be introduced to activities which develop new skills and develop their particular strengths.

The children will begin to learn about paying attention and concentrating as well as expressing emotions and emotional need. Every day will bring opportunities to develop the ability to cope with change.

During this topic Nursery children are going to be finding out all about themselves, their new friends in the class and all of the exciting things they can do now that they are at Nursery.

**The children will:**

- Play with bricks, blocks, sand, and in the house.
- Paint pictures of themselves.
- Listen to stories.
- Sing songs.
- Count.
- Learn everyone's name.

## CULTURAL

### **This term we are going to learn about France.**

#### **The children will learn to:**

- Understand that France is a different country where people speak a different language.
- Look at France on a world map and compare it to the UK.
- Sing simple songs in the target language.
- Learn to count from 1-5.
- Explore French traditions and the food that is eaten there.

## MUSIC

#### **The children will learn to:**

- Learn to recognize a range of percussion sounds.
- Sing simple songs and rhymes with and without actions.
- Learn how to follow a beat and keep with it using a range of percussion instruments.
- Participate in call and response activities and learn how to take turns.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

#### **The children will learn to:**

- Copy and perform basic fundamental skills.
- Use fine/large movements during skills.
- Play simple games with rules.
- Be safe in PE – how to handle equipment and listen to instructions.

## PHSE

#### **The children will learn to:**

- Know class rules 'flush and wash'.
- Be aware of school rules.
- Be aware of their own responsibilities for actions.
- Demonstrate good manners – including lining up, please and thank you.
- Demonstrate sensible behavior beyond school (e.g. trips and visits including avoiding strangers).
