



The Power of Music – Peripatetic Lessons at Belvedere Prep

As we look ahead to the new school year, we're thrilled that more than 100 pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 are currently taking part in individual peripatetic music lessons each week. These lessons include singing, guitar, piano, saxophone, clarinet, flute, drums, violin, and cello.

At Belvedere Prep, we believe in the importance of providing musical opportunities as part of a well-rounded education. Learning an instrument or taking vocal lessons not only supports academic progress but can also strengthen future secondary school applications. Music develops key skills such as concentration, memory and coordination. Music also provides a valuable outlet for creativity and self-expression.

The benefits don't stop there. Music also supports language development by exposing children to a rich variety of sounds, lyrics and rhythms; helping to build vocabulary and even introduce elements of other languages. Playing an instrument engages both sides of the brain, boosting focus and problem-solving abilities.

We understand the importance of balancing musical learning with classroom lessons. Our peripatetic teachers carefully plan rotating timetables to ensure that children do not miss the same subject each week. While some sessions may occasionally overlap with a portion of break or lunch, pupils always have time for a snack and some outdoor time. If part of a class lesson is missed, teachers make sure any key learning is caught up. As pupils move into Years 5 and 6, we make every effort to schedule music lessons outside of core subjects like English and Maths. If preferred, some sessions can be arranged to take place during break or lunchtime.
